ACCREDITATION STANDARDS, CRITERIA AND RUBRICS

The Procedures Manual identifies six Standards. These are:

1. Leadership
2. Teacher Performance
3. Data Management
4. National Curriculum Standards, Benchmarks and Student Learning Outcomes
5. School Campus, Classrooms and Facilities
6. School Improvement Planning.
